Please fill out a white Termination Notice in the Registrar's Office as soon as possible! This is very necessary and will simplify things for both the Administration and YOU!

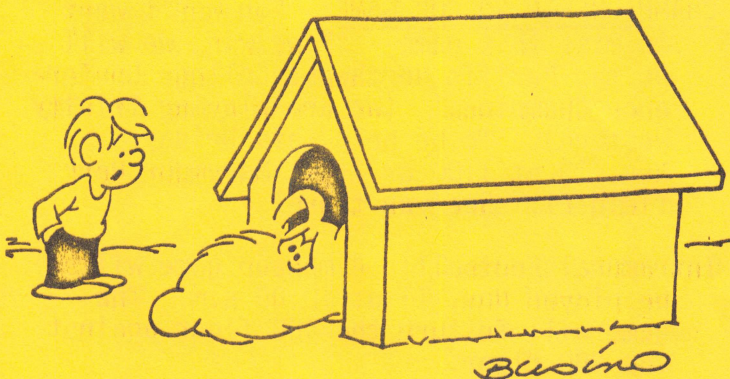
OPERATION TURKEY:
