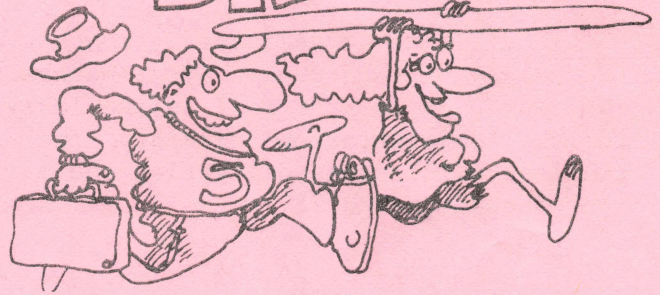
The Library hours during Final Exams:

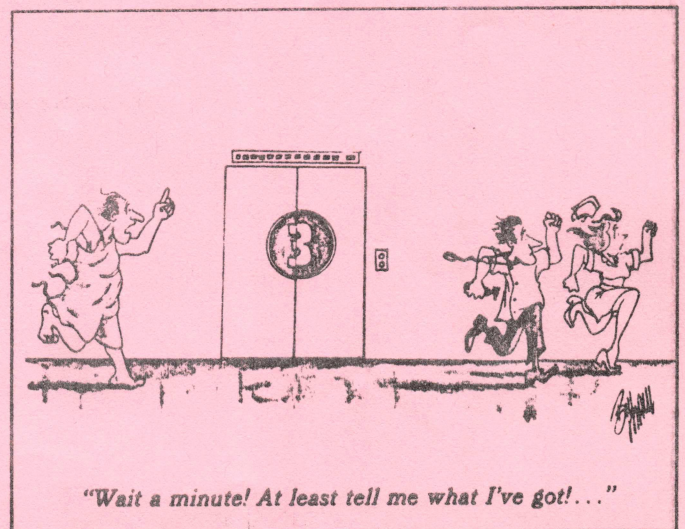
