SUMMER Pastoral Internship: All those doing internship this summer will need to follow these steps:

1. Present a written proposal of your summer involvement (what you will be doing) to Professor Braddy, who will add his requirements.
2. Register for internship at Registrar's Office before June 2.
3. Submit an evaluation of the internship along with the Pastor's report to Professor Braddy at the beginning of the Fall Quarter for a grade.

Pre-requisites for summer Pastoral Internship are:

1. Must have taken Pastoral Ministries I, II and III and Homiletics I or:
2. By special permission of Professor Braddy. (Only open to those who have reached Junior status.)

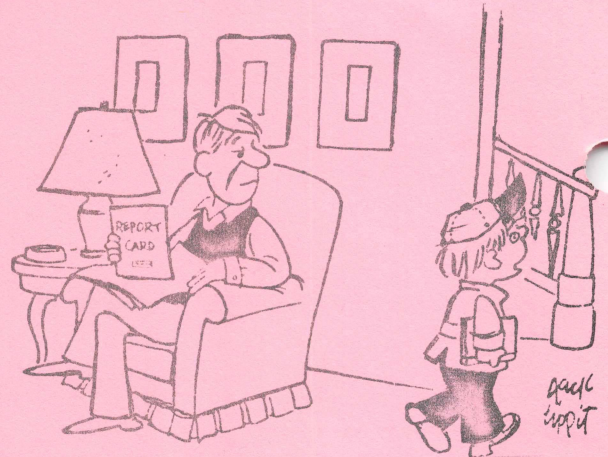

REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER SCHOOL ENDS JUNE 2 so get your registration in now!!! Please clip this piece of paper, fill it out, and turn it in to the Registrar's Office.

Accounts must be cleared before finals on the following basis:

1. Paid in full by May 23.
2. If balance on May 23 is \$100.00 or less and will be paid by June 30, a promissory note must be signed in the office of the Business Manager. This must be done by May 19.
3. All others should apply for the special bank loan (applications available from the Business Office) available to NC students to be repaid over the summer. This may be done after May 12 and before May 23.
