SUMMER Pastoral Internship: All those doing internship this summer will need to follow these steps:

1. Present a written proposal of your summer involvement (what you will be doing) to Professor Braddy, who will add his requirements.
2. Register for internship at Registrar's Office before June 2.
3. Submit an evaluation of the internship along with the Pastor's report to Professor Braddy at the beginning of the Fall Quarter for a grade.

Pre-requisites for summer Pastoral Internship are:

1. Must have taken Pastoral Ministries I, II and III and Homiletics I or:
2. By special permission of Professor Braddy. (Only open to those who have reached Junior status.)

Dorm and Key Deposits: For students graduating from Northwest College or not returning for other reasons, are available only after the student has completed the check out process with the resident deans and the proper forms have been submitted to the office. This takes several working days to provide this. These would be mailed to those requesting them. Students who plan to return should leave their dorm and key deposit with the college in order to reserve housing for the subsequent quarter.
