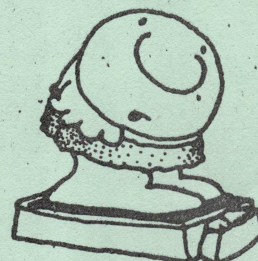
CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION:

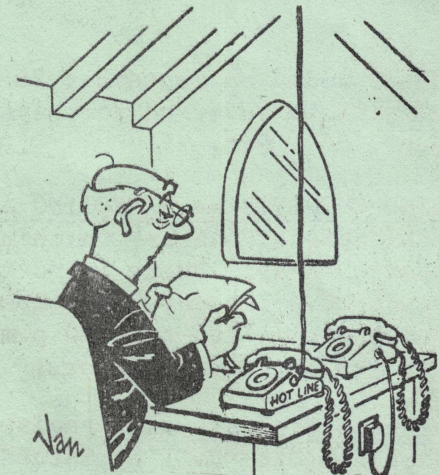
P.R. SING Thursday, October 2, 7:00 pm
