This coming Friday, December 5th, is the last day to drop classes for the fall quarter.

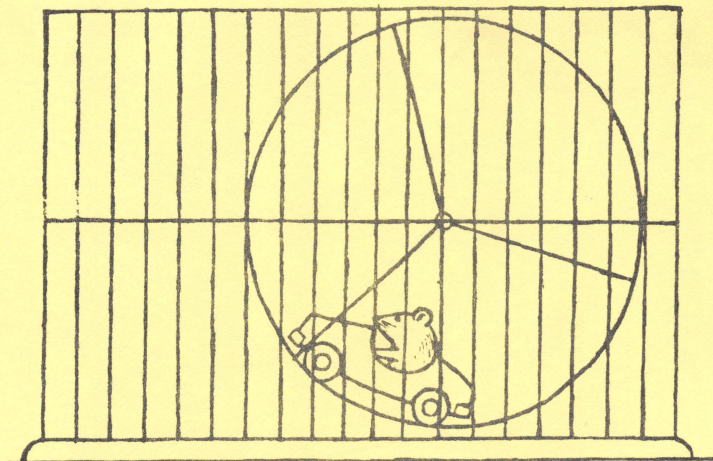
All Library books must be returned and all fines paid by December 3. Any student having an unpaid fine will be unable to take finals. Please pay at the Library.

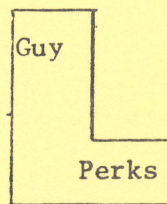
