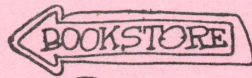

#### INTERIM HOUSING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS:

The residence halls officially close for the quarter after Dec. 10. Residence housing after that date is available only upon approved application. The procedure is as follows:  
1. Student must fill out Interim Housing Request Form in person prior to December 11. Forms are available

at the Administration Building with detail instructions.

2. Room charges of \$3 per night must be made in advance.
3. Only students with approved forms on file with the resident deans are authorized to be in the dorm after Dec. 10.
4. Any student in the resident hall without proper authorization and approval is submit to a charge of \$10 per night.
