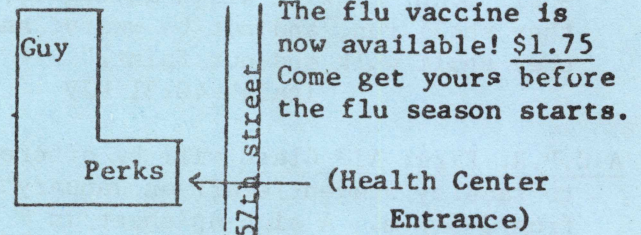
SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS WEEK January 11-16
