Next Monday, February 9 David duPlessis will minister in chapel. Rev. duPlessis first began his ministry in South Africa and held the position of secretary of the Apostolic Faith Mission back in 1936. He was involved in bringing about the first world pentecostal conference and then was secretary for subsequest world pentecostal conferences. For 35 years he has traveled around the globe contacting more church leaders and church bodies than perhaps any other pentecostal, bringing to them an awareness of what pentecost is all about and being used as an inspiration to bring unity and fellowship along the lines of charismatic renewal. He has visited more seminaries and liberal institutions speaking on behalf of the pentecostal message than perhaps any other figure in pentecost. He was launched on this worldwide ministry largely as a result of a deep spiritual experience wich he had in encounter with Smith Wigglesworth. He has met with misunderstanding through much of his ministry but has pursued his calling and has lived to see far-reaching results flow from his efforts. His message to the students and faculty of Northwest College will do much to bring insight into the great charismatic movement which is now taking place around the world.
