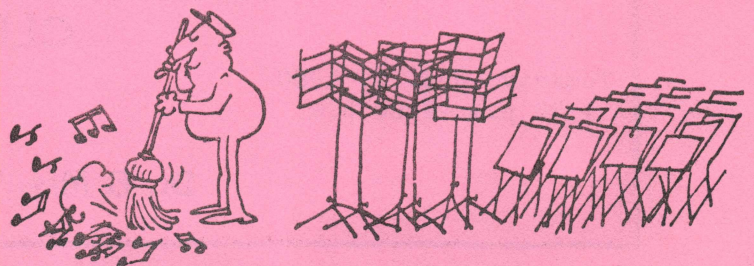

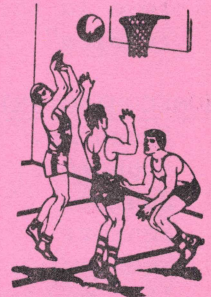

The J.V. Team is NOW 3 - 0 in the League play. Come and watch them play Neighborhood Church Tuesday night at 6:30.



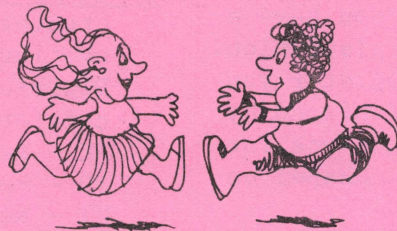
