## Update on BEOG and GSL for 1981-82

Basic Grant applications are now being processed after a long delay. If you have already applied, you should look for your Student Eligibility Report in about four more weeks. There is quite a backlog of applications, so the BEOG processor is asking students to be patient. Please send your SERs to Bev Johnson just as soon as you receive them so she can process the rest of your financial aid award (if you applied for the other aid through FAF).

GSL applicants for 1981-82 are strongly encouraged to file now. There are still revisions going through Congress that will change your eligibility for the loan later on. Loans processed before these revisions take effect will be under the more lenient provisions. See Bev Johnson now for GSL application forms.
