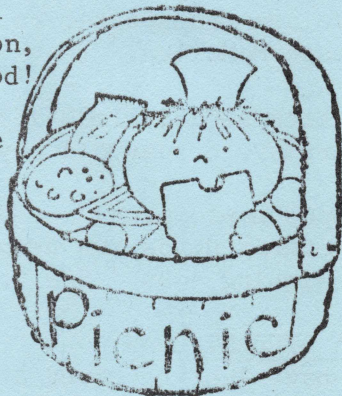

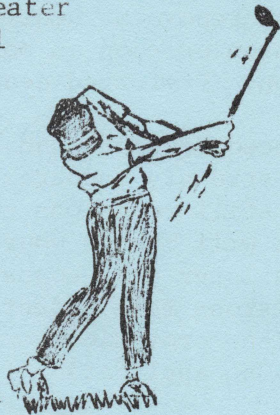

Babysitter needed 11:30-3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 6 year old boy. See Bessie McMullen.

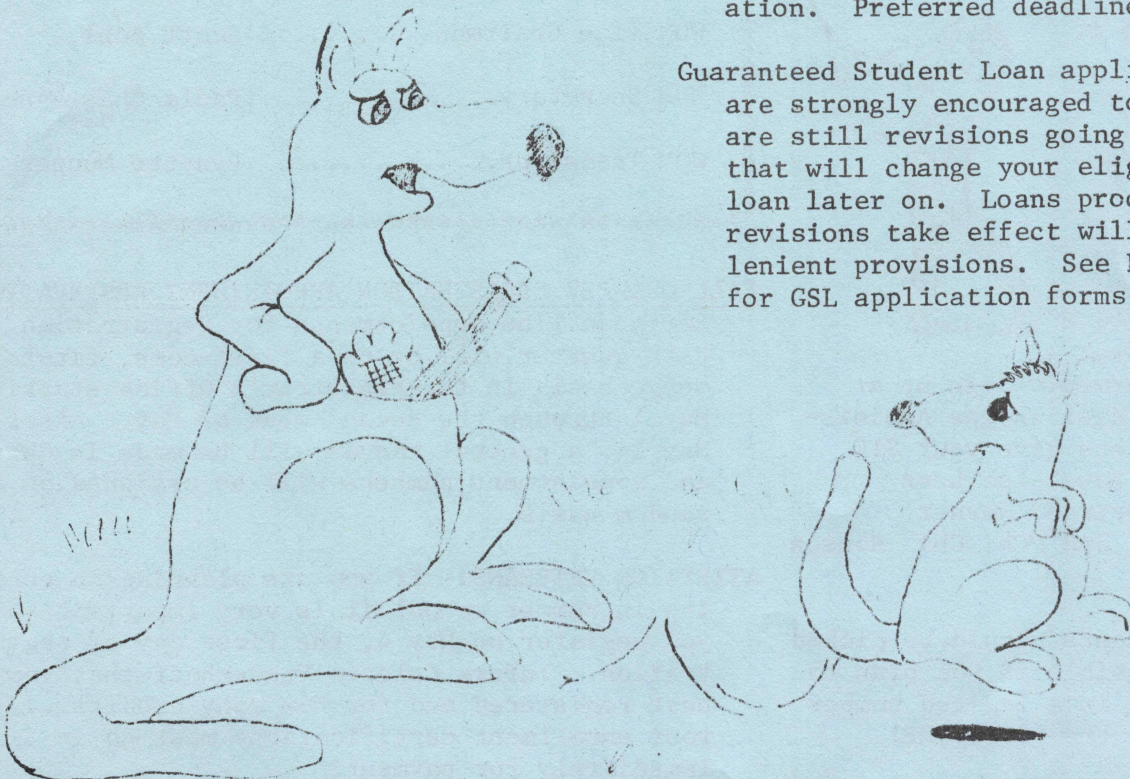
