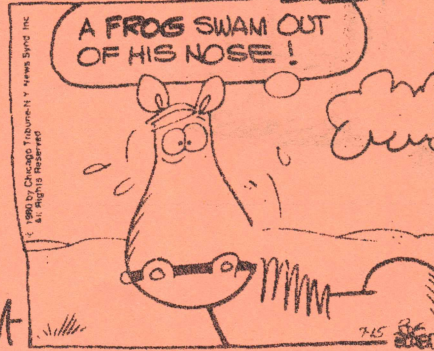
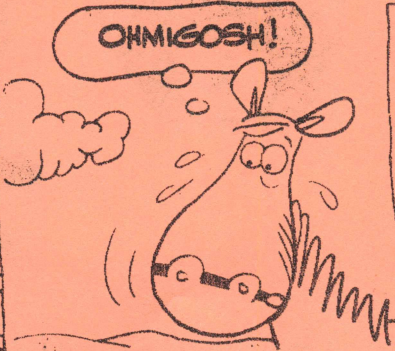
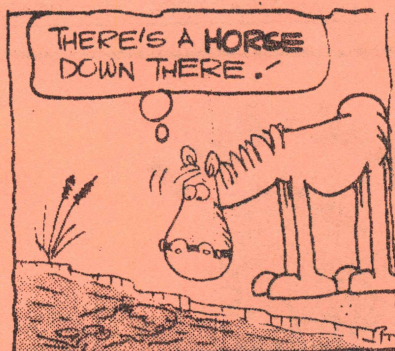
Cripp's Cramming Corollary

Life is like an ice cream cone... You have to learn to lick it!

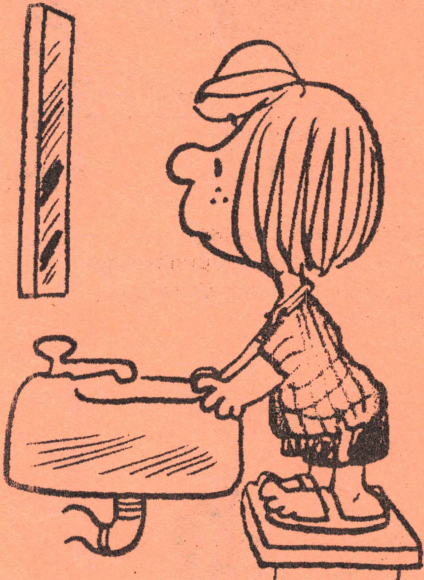
Prosecran's Rule of Final Exam Studying

Any time you study hard and do well on your test, the class curve will bring your grade down.

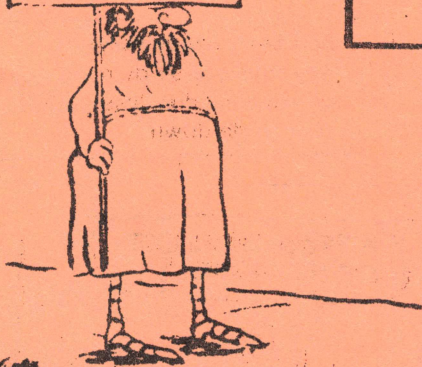

The person in front of you in the cafeteria line will always get a bigger plate of spaghetti.



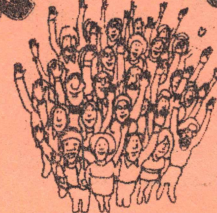
Corollary 1: This statute does not hold true when Spinach Surprise Supreme or Fish Hash is served. You'll get a double helping.
