

ATTENTION!!! STUDENTS !!! THESE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION COURSES WILL BE OFFERED NEXT QUARTER:

ECE 263 Evaluative Techniques, 5 credits offered at the 4th period. It is Tests and Measurements in Education highlighting OBJECTIVES, TESTING, GRADING, THE NORMAL CURVE, STATISTICS, PRESCHOOL TESTING AND EVALUATION.

ECE 365 Practicum I - Student teaching in the early childhood education environment or setting (Preschools, daycare and kindergarten) It requires 5 hrs. per week in the setting and 1 hour of class. It is a 3-credit course. Some students work and get Practicum credit as an added bonus to a salary.

ECE 368 Administration of ECE, the evening class, on Thursdays from 6:30-9:00 p.m. This is very beneficial for those who wish to direct work in Preschool or Daycare Programs. It provides a basic understanding on how to start a Preschool and Daycare Program in the Church - 3 credits.

ECE 399 Creative Methods in ECE- offered in the daytime this quarter. It will be conducted at the 2nd hour; it's a 3 credit course featuring Storytelling, Creative Drama, Music, Spiritual Guidance, Poetry, Games and Fingerplays for young children. Bible Storytelling is unique in this class.
