ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS !!!

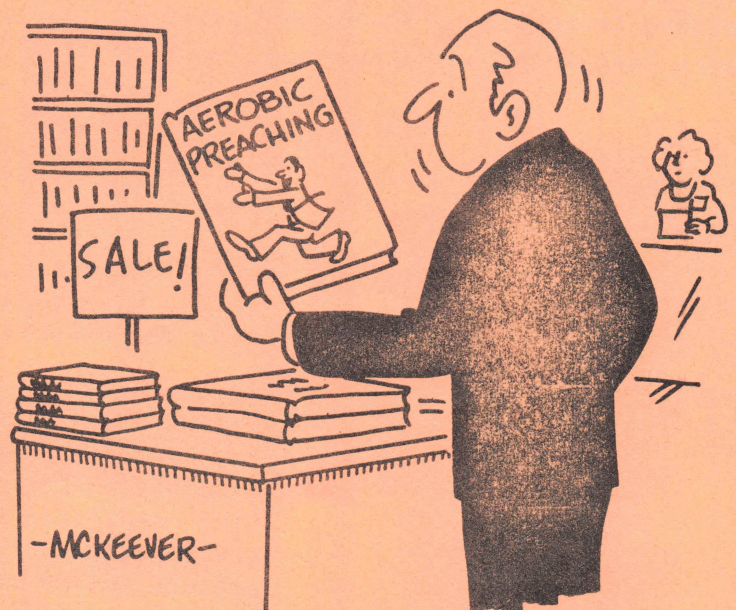
