Surprise!

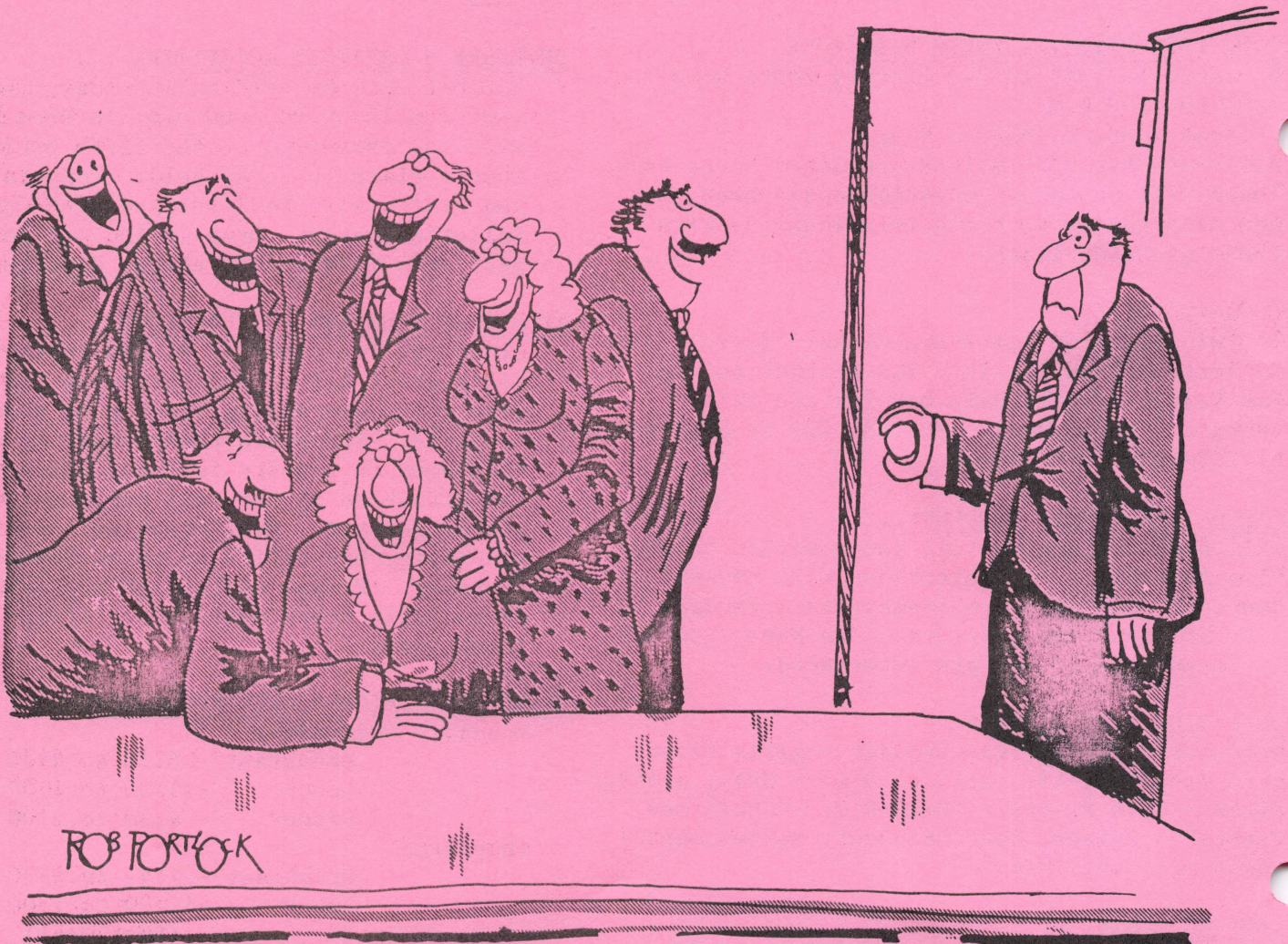
Rules:
