Lost: Contact lenses in the contact lense case somewhere in the area of Perks Lounge. If found, please contact Babette Ramsey who will see that the owner gets them.

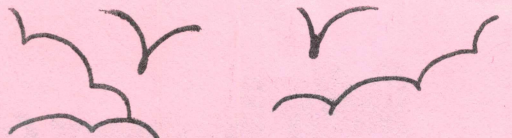
Notice: All students who will not have their account paid in full by March 12, must sign a promissory note by March 12 in order to take finals. You can sign a promissory note at the Cashier's window.
