

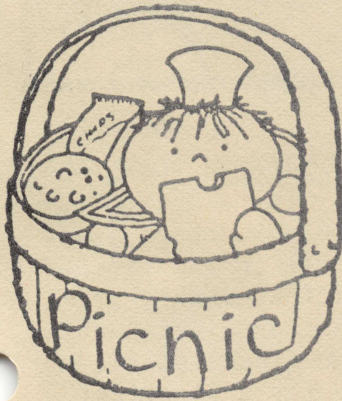

Don't miss the fun and exciting annual ALL SCHOOL PICNIC!!!

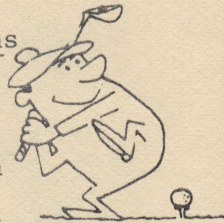
Vans will leave from the front of Guy-Perks Hall at 9:15 a.m., softball games will start at Marymoor Park at 9:30 a.m.

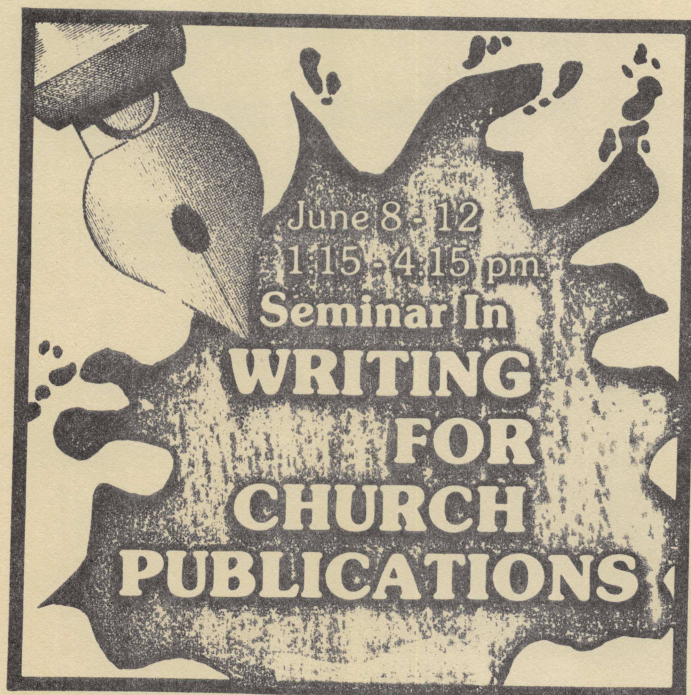
Do you have an unpaid balance on your account? If so, unless it will be paid in full on or before May 28, you must do one of the following: 1) If the balance is less than \$100 and will be paid in full by June 30, you must sign a promissory note. Please see the cahier or the secretary to the Business Manager. 2) If the balance is over \$100, arrangements have been made for a short-term loan from a local bank. PROCEDURE: Pick up an Information Bulletin and Credit Application from the cashier, fill out one of the applications and bring it in person to the secretary of the Business Manager. Your request will be processed and additional instructions given at that time. This should be done between May 17 and 28. Act early. Only students who have cleared their accounts will be permitted to take finals. NOTE: This loan privilege will not be extended to students graduating with their BA or to AA graduates who will not be returning to NC in the fall of 1982.

Important: Students who received Freshman Scholarships and Tuition Discounts for the 1981-82 academic year: Now is the time to submit your request for discount for the coming 1982-83 school year. Pick up a Freshman Scholarship Renewal or Tuition Discount Form at the reception desk in the Adm. Bldg. and submit the completed form to the Business Office as soon as possible for immediate processing.

GSL Borrowers for 1981-82 If you have not received your Guaranteed Student Loan check and you have applied for a GSL through the exception loan program (sent your GSL application to the Washington state guaranty association) and your lender is Citibank, you should contact Citibank immediately if your application, corrected application, or promissory note has been returned to them for over eight weeks from the date you sent it. This word comes from the Washington state guaranty association. Please call Citibank's toll-free number (1-800-828-6103) and have the following information ready when you call: 1) Your Social Security number, 2) copies of the documents you have sent them and/or 3) a list of documents and the dates they were submitted, at hand for reference. The best time to call them is from 3-5 p.m. weekdays PDT. See Bev Johnson if you have questions. Thank you!!!
