Do you know your blood type? You can find out by donating blood—today is the last day the Bloodmobile will be on campus—near the fountain from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.—if you haven't signed up, you can still give blood.

Do you have an unpaid balance on your account? If so, unless it will be paid in full on or before May 28, you must do one of the following: 1) If the balance is less than \$100 and will be paid in full by June 30, you must sign a promissory note. Please see the cahier or the secretary to the Business Manager. 2) If the balance is over \$100, arrangements have been made for a short-term loan from a local bank. PROCEDURE: Pick up an Information Bulletin and Credit Application from the cashier, fill out one of the applications and bring it in person to the secretary of the Business Manager. Your request will be processed and additional instructions given at that time. This should be done between May 17 and 28. Act early. Only students who have cleared their accounts will be permitted to take finals. NOTE: This loan privilege will not be extended to students graduating with their BA or to AA graduates who will not be returning to NC in the fall of 1982.

RESIDENCE HALL CHECK OUT PROCEDURE must be followed by all students whether leaving for summer or staying in residence halls but moving to a different room. Rooms must be cleaned and put in the order they were when school began in September. All beds must be set up properly with all furniture (desks, chairs, etc.), in the room. Students will be held accountable for missing furniture, damaged property, or rooms left without being cleaned. All room and mailbox keys must be turned in.

DORM DEPOSIT is not available for refund as long as a student is registered to return to college. Students should apply for a dorm refund only when they have completed their program or terminate for other reasons.

Charges assessed for <u>SUMMER SCHOOL</u> are on a cash in advance basis. Students needing additional finance would qualify for a short-term loan at a local bank by applying through the Business Office. Bookstore charges are to be in cash, unless covered by Rehab. or a credit on account.

Interim Housing--Students planning to remain in the residence halls past the closing date (June 4), must obtain and complete an Interim Housing Form from the receptionist in the Administration Building, or from your resident dean. The cost is \$3.00 per night for double occupancy, and \$3.75 per night for single occupancy. Students must pay for each night in advance. Leaving possessions in a room constitutes "occupying the room", and carries the same charge as stated above. If students are discovered staying in the residences without the above authorization, a fine of \$10 per night will be imposed. Interim Housing runs from June 4 through September 18. Any student choosing to abide in the residence halls during the interim are reminded that they must follow the guidelines/policies of the College or be These guidelines are subject to removal. listed on the Interim Housing Form.




