GSL APPLICANTS:

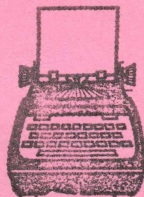

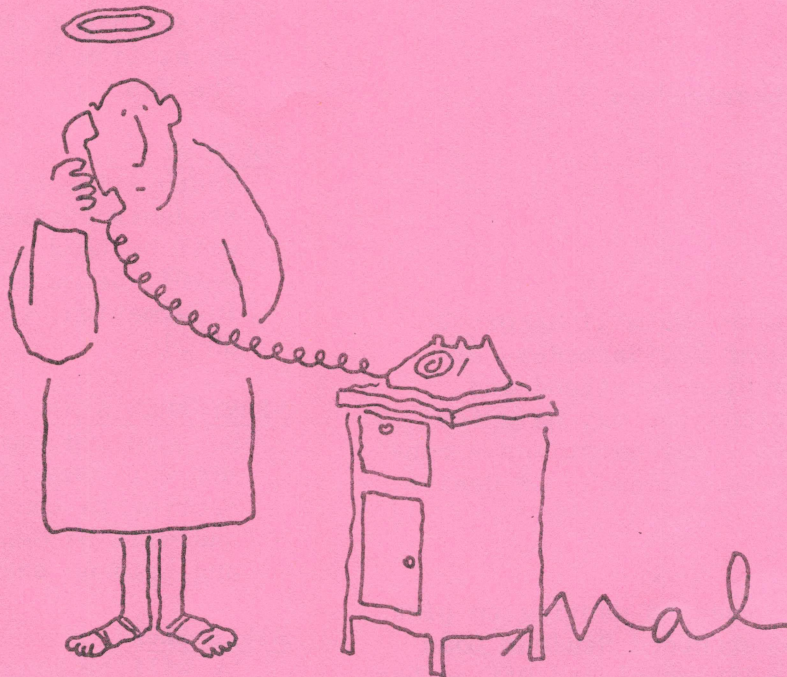
