EVANGELISM MIG ...

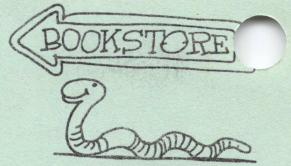
Again this Friday the Evangelism MIG will gather together in prayer and street witnessing for the downtown area. Come prepared to be blessed. 6:30 in the SUB.

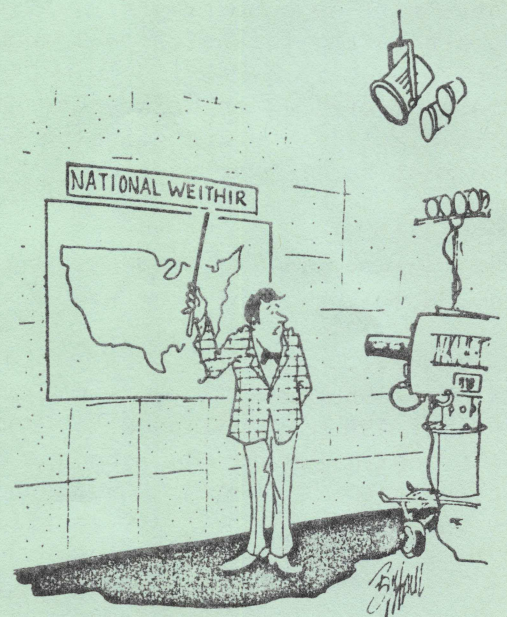
