1983-84 FINANCIAL AID APPLICANTS!

In answer to several questions that are being asked, please note the following information:

- 1. Your Financial Aid Form should be completed only after you know exactly what your income was for 1982 and how much income tax you will pay (not what was witheld from your checks) on that income. Do not file your FAF using estimated income! It creates more problems that it solves even though you may file it a couple of weeks earlier.
- 2. Guaranteed Student Loan applications for 1983-84 will not start being processed by lenders until approximately April or May. The GSL Needs Test which accompanies the GSL application is not yet available for distribution. Students interested in a GSL for next year should plan to apply during the coming spring quarter not before that time.
- Special Condition Forms (special Pell Grant application) will not available until March.

"Mother of Courage" a true story, about the Mother of the man who founded Burden Bearers. What God helped her go through caused her son to start that ministry.


