STUDENT ACCOUNTS:

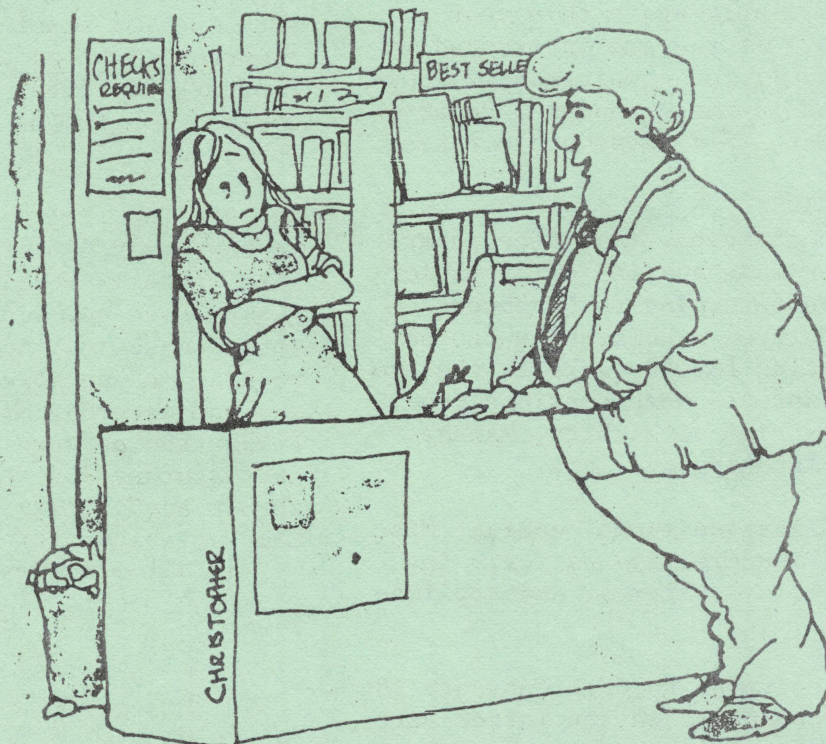
Any unpaid balances on the Winter Quarter accounts are now delinquent. Payment should be made now so that you can be cleared to take final examinations.
