GUARANTEED STUDENT LOANS - 1982-83

If you are going to need extra help to pay off your spring quarter bill, you should apply for a Guaranteed Student Loan as soon as possible. Many banks are no longer accepting GSL applications for 1982-83, but several banks still are - HOWEVER - their cut-off dates for accepting GSL applications are rapidly approaching. This means you need to apply RIGHT NOW, if you need a Guaranteed Student Loan to help you pay off spring quarter. Forms are available in the Financial Aid Office. Thanks!
