MARRIED STUDENT SOCIAL - COMING - MARCH 25th !!!!!!!

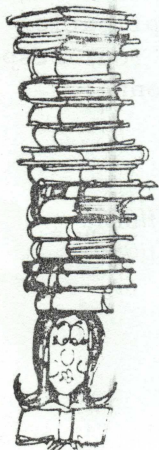
