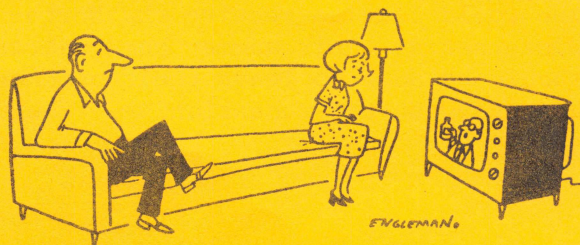
ATTENTION ALL GRADUATES !!!
