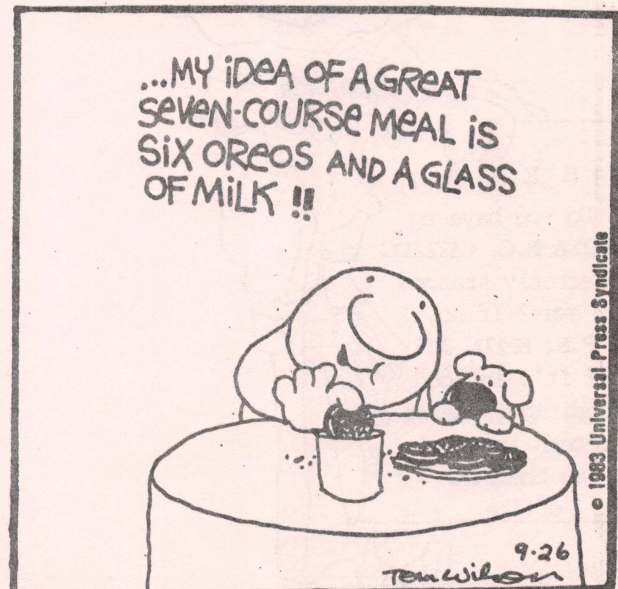

Registration is open this week - Oct. 3-7 and closes thirty days before the election on November 8. When you register use the College legal street address - 11102 NE 53rd, Kirkland, WA 98033. Remember, an important senate race is on to fill the vacant seat left by Sen. Henry Jackson. And President Hurst is running for city council. He now serves as Mayor but his term expires the end of the year. (After the election the Council selects the Mayor for a two year term.) You can vote in his election if you live and are registered in Kirkland. The place to vote is close by N.C. - at the special education's facility on 67th and 111th N.E.

LIBRARY IDERS-

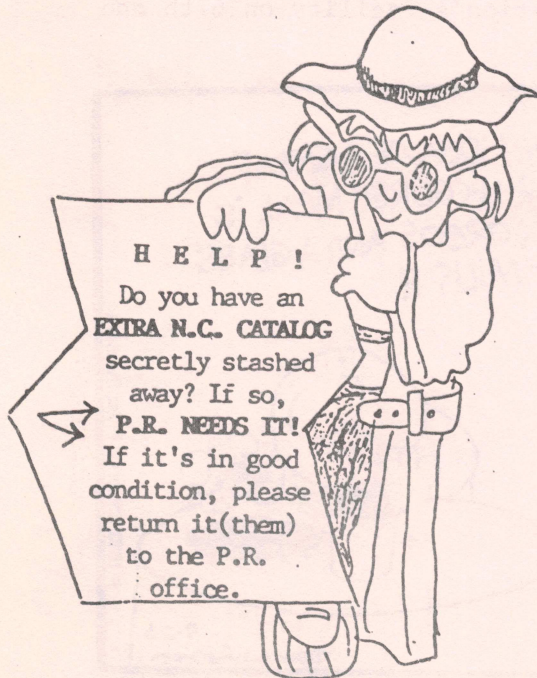
All Students must show their yellow student ID cards for each use of materials in and out of the library. Cards may be obtained at the registrar's office during business hours.
