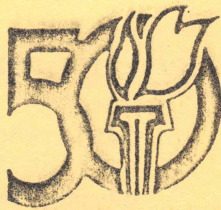

should revolve around three important factors:

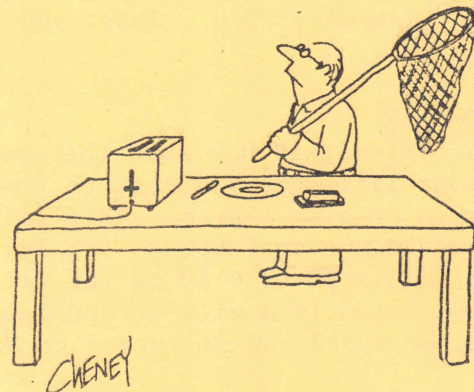
- 1) What are my friends doing?

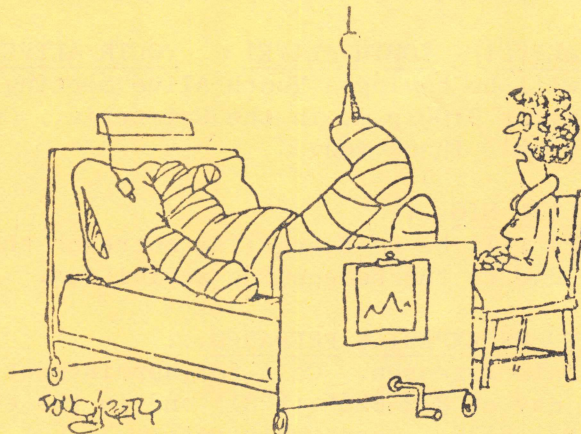
