You can pick up your Resident Assistant application from your Resident Dean - Dean John Young or Dean Virginia Mathison. You need to do this as soon as possible if you are interested.



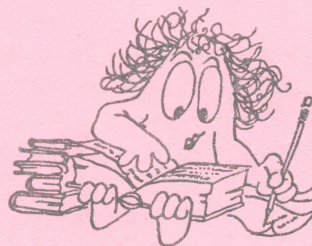
