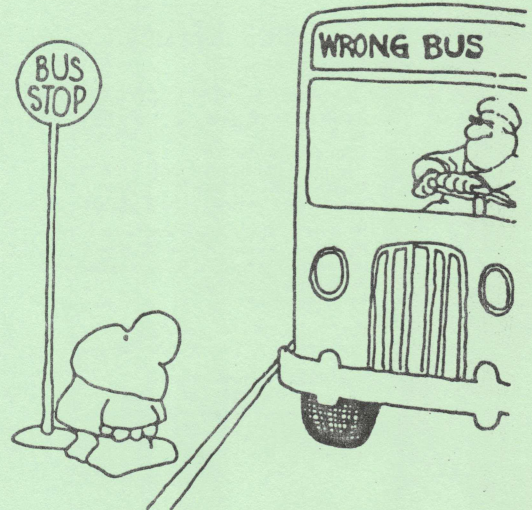

THE BELLEVUE RAMADA INN...

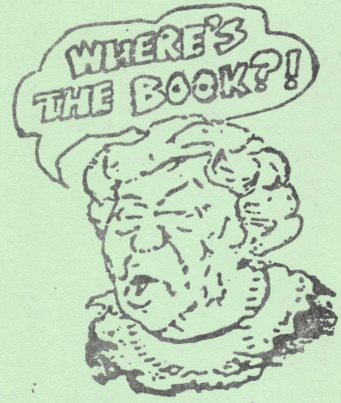
will be running a special price for their motel rooms on graduation weekend for parents and families. A flyer with details is available at the receptionist's desk.
