NEED A COLLEGE VAN?

Here are some guidelines

- Apply early...do not wait until the day before to request use of a van. Please allow, at the <u>VERY MINIMUM</u>, one week. Please note that vans are issued on a priority basis. When the priority is equal, vans will be issued on a first come, first served basis.
- 2. Pick up the keys at the recpetion desk the day you need the van. Pick them up on Friday if you need them over the week-end.
- 3. Return the vans to the garage area PROMPTLY. Do not leave them at the dorms or any other building. Others need access to them the day after.
- 4. Make sure that you have cleared the vans of all equipment at your earliest convenience. We have people who need to use the vans constantly. If you come in late on a particular evening, make sure you have made arrangements to have the van cleared of all equipment the very next morning, (on Monday if it is a week end).
- 5. Please submit a separate request for each van needed as well as for each activity. The mileage MUST be recorded separately for each trip as well as each van.
- 6. Do not sign up to drive a van if you have not been approved by the Business Office to be added to the school driver's list. Even if you have an Intermediate License, you must be on our approved driver list in order to drive a school van.

Thank you for your cooperation in these guidelines. When followed properly, these guidelines will benefit all concerned.
