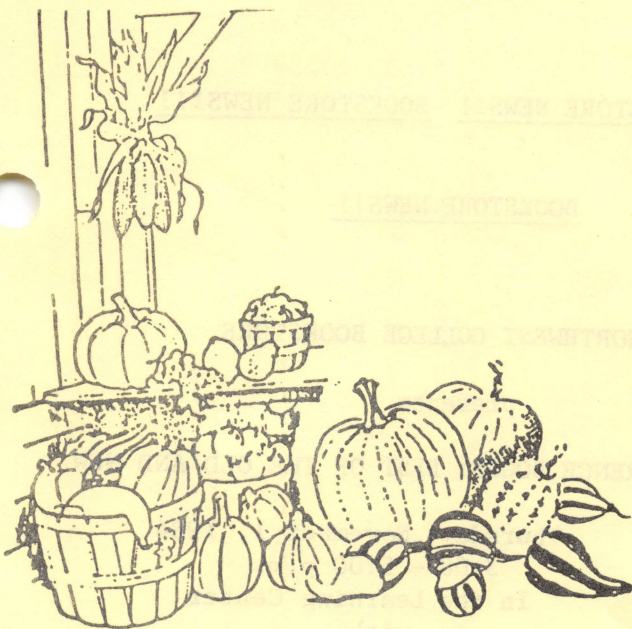

WOMEN'S VARSITY BASKETBALL

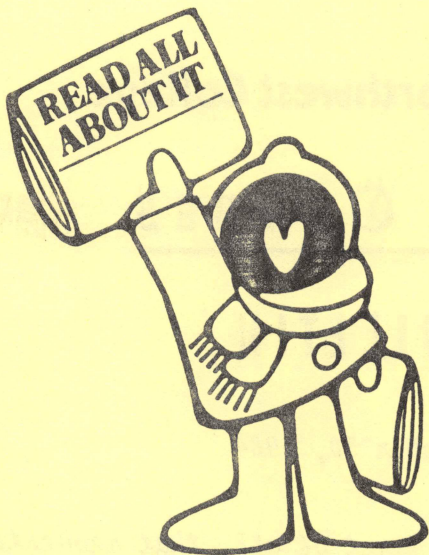

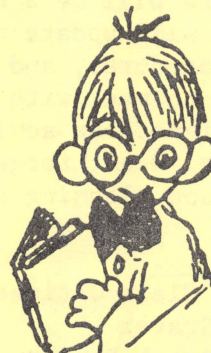
