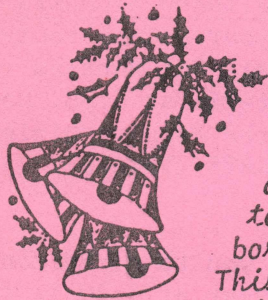

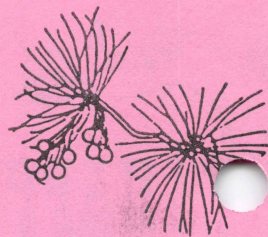
Christmas! This 'noteworthy' event will take place tonight, November 29th, in the Chapel. Be there!!
