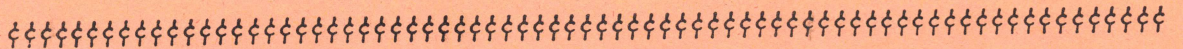

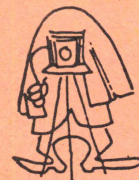
THE SENIOR CLASS SKATE...
