Do not park in the stalls in front of the chapel. These are reserved for faculty! Thank you.

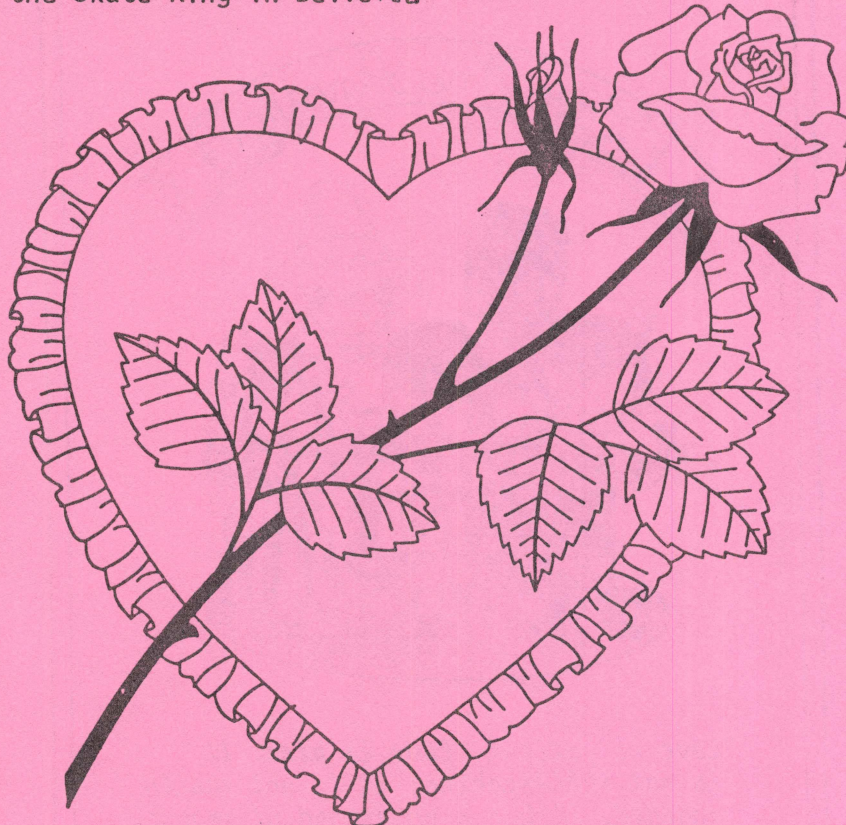
