

"WALKING POLICY"

In the Student Handbook you will find a policy which states: "Students are authorized to leave without being counted absent if the instructor fails to appear within the first ten minutes of the class period." As the Academic Dean, I would like to clarify this for you. It is assumed that any time an instructor has not appeared by 10 minutes into the class period, (except immediately following chapel), that the entire class would leave. It is considered inappropriate for the faculty member to arrive after 10 minutes and expect to teach. Let me encourage you students, if a faculty member has not arrived within 10 mins. the entire class should leave. If it is happening repeatedly, please make an appointment to see me. Obviously, on occasion it is to be expected as faculty members have many responsibilities and activities that impact their time. In fact, it may be their concern for students that would cause them to be late, e.g. counseling, answering questions from a previous class, praying with a student, long distance phone calls, etc. Thank you.
