

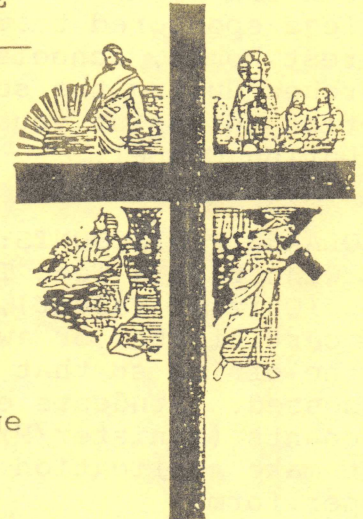

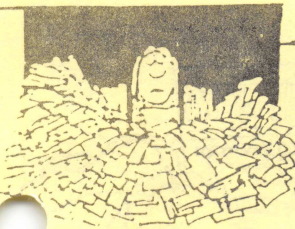
Students should pick up their mail at the reception desk until further notice. Even if you live on Campus, please check to see if mail has been delivered to the receptionist desk for you.

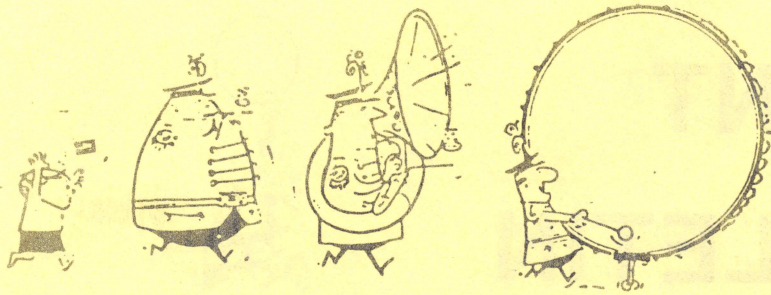
When delivery begins, students should check their mail box regularly. Unclaimed mail will be returned to the sender.

CHANGE IN CLEP TEST FEES:  
Effective Sept. 10, 1985 we have  
had to make the following adjustments  
in charges for CLEP tests due to  
procedural changes by the CLEP  
administration: The fee for tests  
taken and scored locally will still  
be \$30.00. For tests taken here but  
scored in New Jersey, the fee will now  
be \$45.00. For specific subject tests,  
a \$5.00 nonrefundable deposit must be  
paid before any test can be ordered.  
Once the test is taken, that deposit  
will be applied towards the cost of  
the test. If a student, regardless  
of the circumstances, is unable to  
take a specific subject test ordered  
for him or her, the deposit will be  
forfeited.
