Financial Aid for 1987-88: The Financial Aid forms for 1987-88 have arrived and may be obtained at the Financial Aid Office. Apply early to receive full consideration for all funds for which you may be eligible. The 1987-88 Financial Aid form is somewhat different from the 1986-87 version, please read the FAF carefully as you complete it. If you have any questions regarding completing the FAF, please contact the Financial Aid Office. Thank you.

Will your account be paid in full by Jan. 23? Any student needing payment deferred beyond that date must come to the Cashier and sign a PROMISSORY NOTE for the unpaid balance. This is necessary to validate registration.

BOOKS...Remember book purchases are cash unless there is an overpayment of the account. Plan to save money for BOOKS.

FINANCE CHARGE: To avoid finance charge, payment of account must be made before Friday, January 23. After that date, a finance charge of 1 1/2% will be added to any unpaid balance. An additional 1 1/2% will be added at the end of each month.
