Applications for the following scholarships are now available from the Financial Aid Office. If you are interested in applying for any of these scholarships please contact the Financial Aid Office for additional information.

** Mensa Scholarship Program

Awards will be made on the basis of an essay of fewer than 550 words which describes the applicant's career, vocational or academic goal toward which the scholarship is to provide aid. An application and further information may be obtained in the Financial Aid Office.

** Naval Officers' Wives' Club of Seattle

Those eligible to apply are dependent sons, daughters and spouses of active duty or retired career Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard and NOAA personnel who are at least a college sophomore with a 3.0 or better GPA.

** American College Scholarship Program

Those eligible to apply are any school senior, junior college, undergraduate or graduate student attending an accredited college in the Fall of 1988. Applications must be received by March 1, 1988.
