There has been a change of policy regarding Correspondence credits effective with our new 1990-92 college catalog. "All credits earned through correspondence must be completed prior to the beginning of the final semester preceding graduation." There will be some flexibility in the application of this new guideline for the first year, and exceptions will be granted as needed to seniors who entered NC under a different catalog.
