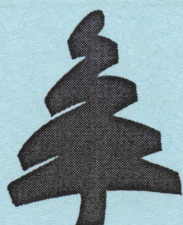

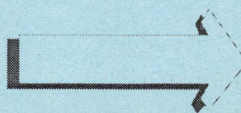

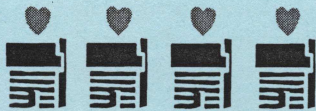
**DEBATE TEAM WINS AGAIN!**
