MANY, MANY THANKS--UPDATE ON DR. FLOWERS:

Our family has had a life changing experience on Friday evening, October 27. Early that Friday morning, Dr. Flowers had an Angiogram exam. The test results showed that he would need Bypass Surgery due to three blockages in his Left Anterior Descending Artery. As he was preparing to leave the hospital on Friday afternoon, he became dizzy and almost fainted. He was immediately rushed to the Critical Care Unit where he was stabilized with oxygen and medication.

Since heart surgeries are done on the Eastside at Overlake Hospital, Dr. Flowers was transferred by ambulance from Evergreen Hospital. During the transfer, he once again experienced a "fainting spell." It was at this point that the surgeon met us and said why wait and risk possible heart damage. So, Friday evening at 9:00 p.m., he went into surgery. They performed a Double Bypass Surgery taking one of the mammary arteries and a vessel from his left calf. By Midnight, he was back in his room with the surgery lasting only 1 hour and 25 minutes.

We are so thankful that Dr. Flowers was at the hospital when all the "action" took place. The hospital was able to stabilize him very quickly both times, so that there was no heart damage according to the surgeon. The past four weeks of recuperation have been a special time of reflection upon the Lord's merciful sustaining grace. Many of the Northwest family have cared for us in tangible ways. All of us in the Flowers family are thankful to be a part of your lives!!
