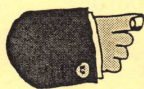

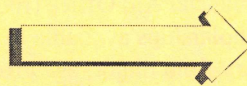


IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO GRADUATE IN THE 1996-97 SCHOOL YEAR be sure to come to the
