DEBATERS WIN AT AIR FORCE ACADEMY

The weekend of October 4, Ryan Doughty and Jacob Witt were judged best Parliamentary debate speakers at the prestigious 38th annual U.S. Air Force Academy Forensics tournament. More than sixty debaters from 22 colleges and universities, including the U of Texas, U of Colorado, U of Denver, U of Wyoming, U of Alabama, Kansas State, Willamette U, and West Point Academy, competed at the three day event on the Air Force Academy's campus in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Ryan Doughty received first place in total points for speaking ability and Jacob Witt serves as captain of the ten member Northwest College debate squad. In addition to being rated for speaking ability, teams are given wins or losses for each round. On Sunday the Witt-Doughty team reached the first of four elimination final rounds after 6 preliminary rounds that were held on Saturday, and then lost on a two to one decision of the three judges.

In addition to winning in debate, Ryan reached semi-finals in the highly competitive events of Impromptu and Extemporaneous speaking. Jacob reached semi-finals in Impromptu.

CONGRATULATIONS to Nick Barth and Kim Maher who qualified for the NCCAA National X-Country Championships in Cedarville, Ohio. Kim was an All-American at last year's National Championships and Nick is the first man in Northwest X-Country or Track history to qualify for nationals. Great job!
