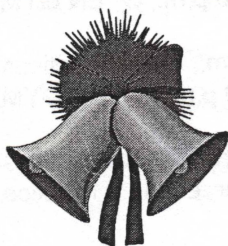

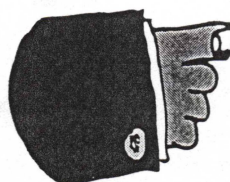
Forms need to be submitted for approval prior to December 13.
