This semester-long program includes weekly service opportunities and **two weeks of travel and study in Israel/Palestine.**

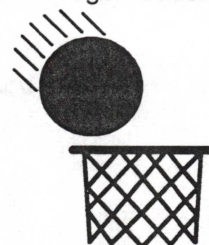

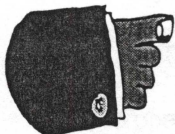
