

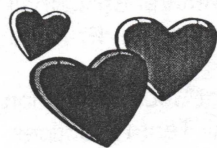

CONGRATULATIONS - The debate team of Sarah Basic and Troy Anderson won **Second Place** junior Parliamentary debate at the Willamette University tournament on January 24 -26. 34 Junior teams from 31 other colleges and Universities attended the event. After six prelim rounds, Sarah and Troy won the votes of all three judges in octo-finals (top 16), quarter finals, and semi finals, then lost in finals against Portland College.
