NEW TOTALS PLACE NC 8TH IN THE

NATION - The 139 member National Parliamentary Debate Association's February rankings put **NC 8th in the nation** for total winning points.

Congratulations for debaters who won at the Western Washington U. tournament last weekend. **Josh Brittingham** and **Doug Lloyd** won First Place novice debate. Josh was also rated the best novice debate speaker and Doug was rated the third best novice speaker. Our senior team of **Sarah Busic** and **Jacob Witt** had 5 wins to 1 losses going into octo finals (top 16 out of 31 teams), when they lost on a 2 to 1 decision of the three judges. The topic for the octo final round was "This house would promote diversity over national unity." Other awards: **Doug Lloyd**--First Place novice prose reading, First Place junior prose and Second Place novice impromptu; **Louise Wall**--Second Place programed reading; **Jeremy Kowalski**--Second Place novice informative; **Jacob Witt**--Fourth Place senior impromptu. Fifteen colleges and universities attended.

interested in applying for this scholarship the application can be found in the scholarship notebook located across the hall from the Financial Planning Office in the Administration Building.

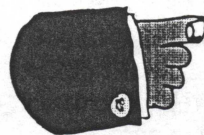
ASB NOMINATION CHAPEL will be Monday, February 24. Please plan to be there.

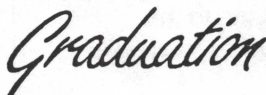
