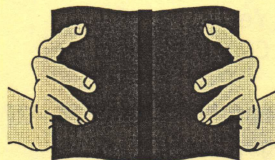

**SPRING BREAK LIBRARY HOURS**

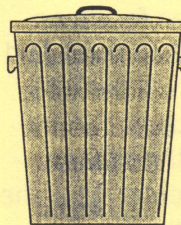
