

Debaters Sweep 15 colleges and universities including Stanford U. attended the Lower Columbia College debate Tournament last

weekend. NC received 2nd Place Sweepstakes for overall winning points. Team captain Jacob Witt was ranked best debate speaker with 170 points--the highest in all three divisions that included 82 debaters. Other wins for Jacob: 1st Place senior Extemporaneous, finalist senior Impromptu. Jacob and partner Josh Brittingham won 3rd Place senior debate, going into semifinals with a 5 to one record. Josh was also a finalist in senior Extemp.

James Stewart was ranked second best junior division debate speaker and won 3rd Place novice Extemporaneous. James and partner Troy Anderson won 2nd Place junior debate, going into finals with a 7 to 0 record. Troy was ranked 4th best junior debate speaker. Troy also won: 3rd Place senior Extemp, finalist Impromptu. Paul Nystrom won 1st Place in novice Impromptu and 1st Place in novice Extemp. Paul was rated 2nd best novice debate speaker. His partner Sveta Zlatarva was 5th best novice debate speaker, won 2nd Place novice Extemp and 3rd place Editorial Commentary. Sheila Holliman won 2nd Place Programed Reading of literature, 3rd Place novice Prose reading, and a finalist in Editorial Commentary. In all, NC debaters won fifteen awards--almost half of last year's total wins.
